THE FOLLOWING ARE THE ONLY SPECIES THAT MAY BE TAKEN WITHIN SD HUNTING SEASONS:

Upland Game: Mourning Dove, Gray Partridge, Sharp-tailed Grouse, Pheasant **Waterfowl:** Ducks, Geese, Coot, Tundra Swan, Common Snipe, Sand-hill Crane **Big-Game:** White-tailed Deer

Ducks Unlimited, Inc. Rules and Regulations for Permitting Access:

1. Fill out Permit in entirety or Permit is Invalid. Detach Original Copy and Place in Drop Box. Detach Carbon Copy and Keep on Your Person. Upon request present this permit to agents or employees of Ducks Unlimited, Inc. and to state law enforcement personnel.
2. Permit is only Valid for current hunting season, beginning the Date of Issuance through the close of the local deer hunting season. However, issuance of permits and access to DU lands may end at any time. Such notifications will be posted at each permit station. 3. DU land open to public hunting is clearly posted with color-coded “HUNTING ALLOWED BY SIGNED PERMIT” signs. BLUE signs indicate DU land open to public hunting from September 1 through the end of the local deer season. RED or ORANGE signs indicate DU land closed to public hunting and access at all times.
4. Obey all South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks Department laws and regulations. Report any violations of South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks Department laws and regulations to TIP's (1-800-592-5522) or your local Conservation Officer.
5. **NO GUIDED, COMMERCIAL, OR OTHER SUCH FEE HUNTING ALLOWED!**
6. **Foot Access Only. Off-road driving and travel** by car, truck, motorcycle, atv, snowmobile, etc. **is strictly prohibited** and will be enforced. This includes retrieval of harvested game.
7. **Overnight camping is not allowed. Open fires and grills are strictly prohibited!** Take every precaution to prevent fires and do not create fire hazards.
8. Respect the rights of others including other hunters, neighboring landowners, or any work that may be in progress by Lessees or Ducks Unlimited, Inc. employees.
9. Use and carry firearms in a safe and proper manner. **No hunting within 440 yards of any occupied dwelling. Do not shoot in the direction of neighboring buildings.** Do not molest livestock or hunt in the vicinity of livestock that may be present.
10. Respect the property by not leaving litter. Keep the area clean by picking up any refuse that you may see including spent shotgun hulls and rifle-cartridge brass. Please dispose of any garbage properly. Do not abuse, destroy, or vandalize any of the property or its improvements.
11. Promptly report any damage to the area to Ducks Unlimited's Land Manager at (605) 439-3329.

Hunting permits are not guaranteed for any length of time. Issuance and validity of permits may end at any time. Permits may not be available to access all lands owned by DU. Land owned by DU that is open to hunting by permit is DU “Revolving Land” which is purchased to protect critical waterfowl breeding habitat. The land is restored and protected and then sold by DU. Hunting access will then be determined by the new landowner. For more information concerning DU land available for purchase see, “Land Sales” at www.ducks.org. Your privilege to hunt on Ducks Unlimited Managed Properties will be revoked for violation of any of the foregoing rules and regulations. Each permittee must read, understand, and agree to the laws, rules and regulations of the South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks Department and to those set by Ducks Unlimited, Inc. and assume all liability while accessing this land.
