DUMAC INITIATIVE: MANGROVES

Eighty percent of the commercial saltwater species captured come from the ocean's coastal areas, and eight percent of those species, depend on mangroves as nursing grounds. It's the equivalent of an estimated \$37,500 a hectare per year. And for every hectare that's destroyed, there's an estimated loss of 800 kilograms of fish and shrimp.
